Beginning April 27:

Mediacom will convert our local educational access channel (Channel 12) to a new digital channel, and the name will change to Red Apple TV. Depending on your TV's technology, **you may need an extra (FREE) piece of equipment to see our channel.** The following provides a basic guide to four common TV configurations.

No extra equipment needed, but you will have to "rescan" your TV to pick up the new channel.
